CONDITIONS of TENDER for FOOD/BEVERAGE/SIDE SHOW SITES

*Tenders are invited by the **Malvern Agricultural & Pastoral Association** (hereinafter called “The Association”) for the right to sell food from **ONE** of the specified sites on The Association’s grounds on the date specified..*

1. For the purpose of this tender FOOD is deemed to be food or beverages that are to be consumed on the premises, on the day of the Show and ENTERTAINMENT is deemed to be side show related entertainment. No alcohol sales will be considered. **Hot chips and Hotdogs** are exclusively provided by the Malvern Lions and the side show, please do not include these with your food sites.
2. Every person/s to acquire such rights make an application in writing on the Official Form overleaf marked ‘TENDER SITE’. This form must be received by - **The Event Administrator, Malvern A&P Association, C/O 1627 Tramway Road, RD 1, Darfield 7571** , or emailed to malvernshow@gmail.com **on or before the date specified**, stating the price which he/she offers for the said rights and the person/s making the application shall date & sign the form together with his/her name & address.
3. The Association **does not** undertake to accept the highest or any tender.
4. Each Tenderer will be advised of the successful tenders by letter sent to him/her via email, addressed to the address given in the tender. This letter will not contain the details of any tender or any evaluation results.
5. Every letter and every notice to any person shall be sent to him/her by The Association via email, addressed to them at the address given to his/her respective tender or at his/her last known address in The Association’s records, and shall be deemed to have been received in due course.
6. The amount tendered shall be payable in one sum, by **the date specified** to the Association.
7. Each tender is to be accompanied by details of the foods, beverages or entertainment it is intended to provide.
8. The Association reserves the right to permit the sale of other foodstuffs elsewhere on The Association’s grounds during the Show. (In addition to the tendered food sites, food will also be available at other locations on The Association’s grounds eg at the catering tent, in association with the licensed booth and at community fundraising sites).
9. The Association’s Committee’s decisions are final.
10. The successful tender(s) will be required to hold any necessary licences for the sale of the food and shall, if called upon, provide evidence that such licences are held. Please attach copies of all relevant licences with this form.
11. The successful tenderers shall supply their own power leads. All successful tenderers shall supply their own caravan or tent from which to conduct sales and shall sell food solely from the site allotted. A RCD fitting **must be fitted** to all power cables supplied by tenderer before connecting to source of power from the Association, if power is available. **Please note:** limited power sites are available, and incur a **\$35 connection fee**.
12. The successful tenderer(s) will insure in some public insurance office against any accident claims and liability whatsoever to or by any person arising from his/her operation under this agreement or from the actual omissions of his/her employees, servants, agents or sub-contractors and will at all times keep The Association indemnified against any such loss or liability.
13. The successful tenderer(s) agrees and undertakes to comply with the Health and Safety in Employment Act 1992, including any amendments and any other Acts of Parliament, regulations or Bylaws and including but not limited to the following: Any relevant food and hygiene Regulations, The Resource Management Act, The Sales of Good Act, The Fair Trading Act, and The Consumers Guarantee Act.
14. The successful tenderer(s) will be issued with **one admission** pass per 4m frontage booked. Extra passes can be obtained at \$15 per pass. Every person entering the showgrounds are required to either hold or purchase an entry pass. Please note: Entry free to Under 16 years and Free Parking.
15. It is at the discretion of the stall holder as to the time they occupy their site, but they **must be set up no later than 8.30am**. Gates open at 7am and the first events commence at 8:30am.
16. **BREACH OF CONTRACT:** Failure to comply with the above-mentioned conditions may lead to termination of the contract and expulsion from The Association’s grounds.

Dismantling of sites may occur after 4.00pm on Show Day. Prior dismantling is by arrangement only with the Site Supervisor or the Event Administrator.

Any contamination or damage to sites caused by Tenderers will be the responsibility of the Tendered to make right or a charge will be made by the Association.
